



## Code of Conduct

The United Kingdom Floorball Federation (UKFF) is focussed on the government and growth of Floorball across the United Kingdom. It is the policy of UKFF that all players, team staff, officials and parents show respect and a spirit of fair play - while demonstrating an understanding and respect for each other. All participating members of UKFF and its affiliates are expected to conduct themselves in a way that reflects the positive principles of UKFF.

### Players and Team Staff:

All players and staff are expected to:

- Take care of all property; be it belonging to UKFF, a UKFF host venue or a fellow UKFF member club, player or staff member;
- Treat match officials and other players with respect at all times on and off the rink;
- Control tempers and avoid behaviour which may inconvenience or upset others.

### Team Staff

UKFF promote:

- Wellbeing and safety of players before the development of performance;
- The development of an appropriate working relationship between players and staff, based on mutual trust and respect;
- The furthering of activities that are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part;
- Consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance;
- The stamping out of the use of prohibited substances.

### Parents/Guardians

UKFF promote the enjoyment of sport, we do not condone:

- A player or players being forced into taking part in sport;
- The punishment or belittling of a player for making mistakes;
- Public disagreement of official's judgments.

UKFF promotes:

- Supporting your child's involvement and helping them to enjoy the sport;
- The use of correct and proper language at all times;
- The setting of a good example by applauding good performances of all players.
